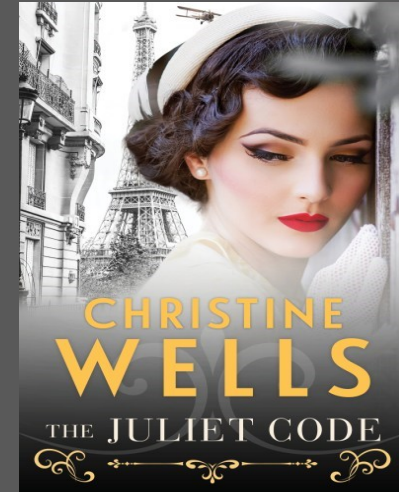
June is a literary lover's month here at the Club,

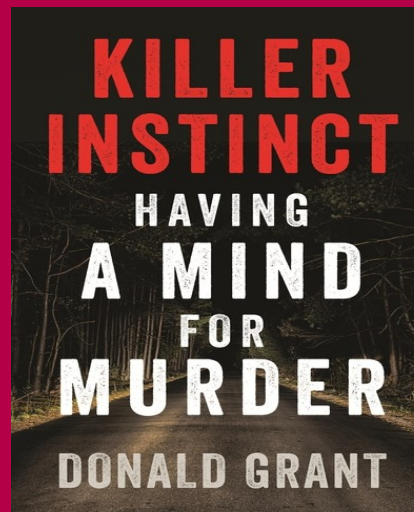
Inspired by real people & events,
