
## WHO WE ARE

### **CLUB HISTORY & HERITAGE**

The United Service Club Queensland was established in 1892, recently celebrating our 130th anniversary since our foundation and our 75th anniversary in our clubhouse on Wickham Terrace.



#### **CLUB MOTTO**

Pro Aris et Focis, which translates roughly as "For God & Country" or "For Hearth & Home". It is the motto of the Royal Queensland Regiment.



#### **CLUB BUILDINGS**

The Club is made up of the Green House (circa 1907) and Montpelier Building (circa 1910). Both buildings were purchased in 1947, and both were designed by respected Brisbane architect Claude William Chambers. Our buildings were Heritage Listed in 1999.



#### **OUR RED ROSES**

Each of the 22 red rose bushes in our Terrace Garden represents one of the 22 Club members who were killed in the Great War. The roses were inspired by the blood red roses at war cemeteries across the Western Front, and were a gift from Past President Major Jenny Walker (our first female Club President) in 2014.



# GREAT WAR HONOUR BOARD

Carved from Queensland maple, the Board lists our 22 Club members who were killed in WWI. Twelve are buried at Gallipoli, eight on the Western Front, one at Beersheba and one in the Russian lakes near Archangel.



### WORLD WAR II HONOUR BOARD

Donated by Past President Colonel Dennis Scanlan CSM RFD in 2015, the Board lists our 27 members who were killed in WWII.



### WAR IN SOUTH AFRICA AND KOREAN WAR HONOUR BOARD

Donated by Past President Brigadier Ray McNab CSC RFD in 2016, the Board lists our four members who were killed in War in South Africa (Boer War) and one who was killed in the Korean War.
